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It is a handicap to be a migrant in a foreign land, to live in rural area, to be unemployed.

What many people undertake these severe disadvantages for?

What are the consequences for themselves, for their family, for their milieu?

What effects has any influence on their health and how?

Can we provide any protection against harmful effects?

Is any official system to give shelter to migrants to guarantee their humane integration to the society?

Are they able to reach health care system; is it available for them?

A great many other questions are raised up in connection to migrants' health in Hungary, in rural areas. Naturally correct, valid answers may not be given in this short time. Well composed assessments, studies, researches must be set up for these. But we have experiences, information from migrants, from health care providers, comparison to previous researches; so I try to give a sketchy panorama on this problem.
